#### Notes to the Financial Statements

#### Organization accounting policies

#### Organization:

The Agoura Math Circle (the Association) was incorporated in 2015 in the state of California. Agoura Math Circle is a free educational program focusing on the problem-solving skills that lead students to success in both academics and the real world. More importantly, Agoura Math Circle gives students confidence and the skills to tackle any type of problem, academic or otherwise.

#### Income taxes:

The Association is exempt from the payment of federal income taxes on its exempt activities under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and has been classified by the Internal Revenue Service as other than a private foundation under Section 509(a)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code. The Association believes that it has appropriate support for any tax positions taken, and therefore, does not have any uncertain tax positions that are material to the financial statements.

The Association's income tax returns are generally subject to examination by the Internal Revenue Service and other state and local taxing authorities for three years after they were filed.

#### Basis of accounting:

The Association prepares its financial statements on the cash basis of accounting. Accordingly, revenues are recognized when cash is received and expenses are recognized when the cash is paid.

# Highlights from 2016

#### Our Class

In 2016, the Agoura Math Circle moved from garage to Agoura High School with 5 class rooms serving about 150 kids. There are about 20 volunteers helping kids in learning math.



Also Agoura Math Circle is a satellite program of UCLA Math Circle.

## Field Trip

In 2016, around 60 kids were taken to a field trip to **VCOE TECH** center were students explored the simulators to fly the aircraft. There students learned about the practical application of Math in real life.



#### Guest lectures

Diallo Wallace, an aerospace engineer at the naval base and a teacher in career center's aviation and engineering programs, gave a hands on experience to kids to create their own orbits. He also gave a presentation to the students about orbital science.



Arul Kolla, a winner of many math competitions, gave a guest lecture to our kids in senior beginner class on "Piecing it together". He is the founder of Raylight, an online initiative that hosts math competitions and gives any little amount earned through the initiative to children who are in need of proper education. He gave his insights about how to solve logical math problems which will be useful for kids to solve Math kangaroo problems.

Dev Saravanan – three year old genius showcased his talent in front of the kids. Our math circle kids quizzed him on the periodical tables, Astronomy, math and biology. He inspired our kids to achieve more and to come out of their comfort zone.

Agoura Math circle becomes an official host for Math kangaroo for 2017. Our students were trained to compete in various competitions like Math Kangaroo, Math Counts, AMC 8 etc.

Our kids competed in AMC 8 and won recognitions with Gold, silver and bronze awards in the respective centers.


